The events that took place are as follows:



**Essay Writing event:** On July 30th, an essay writing event was held in which 10 students participated. The topics given to the students were "History of National Flag", "Importance of Tricolor in Flag" and "Various significant rules for Hoisting the National Flag". The event was successful and all the students submitted their essays on time. The event aimed to create awareness about the importance of our national flag and the rules that need to be followed while hoisting it. It was a great opportunity for students to learn more about the national flag and showcase their writing skills.

- **Sankalp Patr Vachan event:** On August 5th, 2022, a Sankalp Patr Vachan event was held in which 144 participants, including students and faculties, gathered to take a pledge as part of the "Har Ghar Tiranga" campaign. The goal of the campaign is to hoist the national flag in every household.
